



Landscaping the West LRT

IN FALL 2011, meetings were held with community representatives, who provided feedback and participated in the design process with the landscape architects. The boards on display tonight show landscaping concepts that incorporate feedback from these community representatives and align with the project's landscaping design considerations and constraints.

The West LRT landscaping phase will restore areas disturbed by West LRT construction to pre-construction conditions as close as possible. It consists primarily of soft landscaping (trees, shrubs, plantings, etc.) Most hard landscaping (pathways, retaining walls, etc.) will be completed by the Design-Build Contractor throughout 2012.

As part of the West LRT's landscaping phase, there are no plans to plant on private properties, unless something was removed on a private property as part of construction.



SCOPE

The landscaping areas include all West LRT construction zones along the West LRT alignment:

- Shaw Millennium Park
- Six LRT Station areas
- Areas along Bow Trail
- Areas along 17 Avenue S.W.
- Areas along Sarcee Trail
