



Millennium Park Construction

TELUS World of Science and North Parking lot

The West LRT alignment passes through the existing TELUS World of Science vehicle access, the parking underneath the esplanade and a portion of the esplanade structure. To make room for the West LRT, The City is modifying a number of elements in the area to prepare the site for West LRT construction:

- Remove the parking lot under the esplanade structure
- Remove a portion of the esplanade
- Relocate vehicle access to north of the building from 11 St. S.W. (closer to 6th Ave. S.W.)
- Temporarily close the beach volleyball courts
- Extend Millennium Park's north parking lot to accommodate loss of parking stalls
- Modify the west entrance to the building
- Modify the building's drop-off and loading area

Construction Schedule

2009 July	Close beach volleyball courts Construction begins on extension to Millennium Park's north parking lot* Construction begins on the new 11 St. S.W. access *The parking lot extension will accommodate the same number of parking stalls that exist prior to West LRT construction including bus and handicap parking
2009 September	Open extended north parking lot Open new vehicle access from 11 th St. S.W. Permanently close parking under esplanade and current access from 11 St. S.W. Begin building modifications on TELUS World of Science Close access to Millennium Park between Mewata Armoury and TELUS World of Science
2009 December	Complete building modifications including east and west entrances
2012 December	Complete modifications to the east plaza Open new access to Millennium Park between Mewata Armoury and TELUS World of Science
2013 Summer	Open new beach volleyball courts (located just west of current location)
